Registration dates are as follows:

Competition Team and High EnergyAugust 16 4:00 - 5:00

The final payment for the student will be taken August 16. If pre-registered you can come to the front of the line.

Students who have been dancing at Brucie Klay's Dance Center:

All students must register at this time to ensure a place in class. A \$30.00 registration fee per student plus tuition for the first two months of dance lessons is due at this time. No drops will be accepted during the first two months to ensure fairness in scheduling.

Students that have participated in Summer Dance Camps are considered returning students and should register on that day.

About Our Classes

Creative Dance - Offered for ages 3, 4, 5. This class combines Ballet, Jazz, Tap, and Tumbling along with games and props to enhance the children's coordination (**Must be 3 by September 1st**). If your child is turning 3 in October or November you may add your child to be first in line on a particular wait list on August 15th. You may do this by email to the dance center.

Creative Dance for 5 year olds - A combination class with Ballet, Jazz, Tap, and Tumbling (**For Kindergarten age children. Must be 5 by Sept 1st**)

Creative classes are formatted to keep the freedom of movement young children possess and nurture the love of dance to prepare for future training.

Core Classes: We suggest taking two of these technique-based classes per week.

Ballet - Offered for ages 6 and up (**must be 6 by September 1st**)

Jazz - Offered for ages 6 and up (**must be 6 by September 1st**)

Tap - Offered for ages 6 and up (**must be 6 by September 1st**)

Acrobatics - Offered for ages 6 and up (**must be 6 by September 1st**)

Theater Jazz - For dancers age 7 and over, Jazz style used in musical theater productions.

Elective Classes: We suggest taking at least one core class in addition to your elective.

Lyrical - For dancers age 7 and over, a combination of Jazz and Ballet, following the lyrics of song.

Modern - For dancers age 7 and over, a contemporary step beyond ballet.

Street Dance - For dancers age 6 and over, the Break Dance movements of music videos.

Voice and Theater - Acting and vocal training, ages 6 and over, class placement according to age.

Boy's Street Dance - For dancers age 6 - 16, an all boys class of hip hop moves.

Adult Classes, Specialty Classes: Check the schedule and online for updates on any special classes added this year.

Levels for the 2010-2011 school year:

Students who attended Bruce Klay's Dance Center last year, have been placed by the staff in levels for the coming year. This placement is based on the dancer's ability, discipline, and attendance. The teachers will observe these placements during the month of September and use their judgment to make any necessary changes for students who would be better placed in another class. These classes are set up to challenge and encourage all students.

Placement information will be posted on the front door of the studio August 6, 2010 and will also be on our website. (*This placement process does not apply to creative classes*)

Costume Fee

Our procedure for collecting recital costume payments is as follows:

We will be collecting payments beginning in November and ordering costumes in December to ensure a timely delivery.

Costumes will be paid in three payments:

November 1st - \$25.00 per costume

December 1st - \$25.00 per costume

January – Any remaining balance due on costumes. You will receive a printout in January listing the exact amount due. Do not pay \$25.00 like in your earlier payments.

This fee does not include tights or shoes and is a non-refundable payment.

Measurements will be taken during late November and early December.

We will be measuring the child's bust, waist, hips and girth. If the child's measurements are close to two sizes, the larger will be ordered. These costumes are not custom-made; therefore some alterations may be needed. Any late orders taken after December will have \$10.00 added to each costume.

Pictures of the costumes will be displayed in our costume book, available in January.

Recital Fee

There is a recital fee in addition to costume fees that is due in February. The amount is \$65 per family. This payment envelope is included in your payment booklet.

Here is what the recital fee pays for:

- Rental cost of facility
- Professional technical staff: Stagehands, stage manager, house manager, security guards, lighting and music technicians, box office staff.
- Rental of lighting and music equipment
- Mandatory insurance coverage
- Rehearsal Hall
- Back stage manager
- Performance quality recording of recital music
- Stage sets
- Administrative costs
- Recital programs

Tuition and Recital Payment Books

You will receive a payment book once your child begins the dance year. This book will contain payment envelopes for all tuition and recital payments for the 2010-2011 dance year. Please use this booklet for payments mailed or handed into the office.

One payment booklet is available per family; any additional booklets can be bought for \$3.00. Your first payments due will be the month of November and first deposit made towards costumes for recital.
